Roy Kuga is vice president, Grid Integration & Innovation, a new team that was formed in 2016.

Grid Integration & Innovation is responsible for developing policies, strategies and plans for PG&E's grid of the future, including distributed energy resources including energy storage and demand response, transmission and distribution interface, technology pilots, and transportation electrification.

Kuga previously served as vice president, Energy Supply Management, overseeing the company's energy supply, storage and transmission portfolios for electricity, natural gas, financial hedges and greenhouse gas allowances. His responsibilities included power contracting, wholesale market design and bidding PG&E's energy portfolio into California's wholesale market. Earlier in his career, Kuga led the company's strategic planning team for electric industry restructuring, and supported the company through California's energy crisis, and helped build its renewable portfolio.

Kuga has also worked in the oil and gas and telecom industries. He holds bachelor's degrees in electrical engineering and mathematics, and a Masters degree in operations research.
