Gloria Godson is Vice President, Energy Policy, for Conectiv Energy. She heads up Conectiv Energy's regulatory group which supports CE's generation and trading business at FERC, PJM, NYISO, NE-ISO, MISO, various State Commissions and the industry. Gloria serves as a Director of the North American Energy Standards Board and chaired the Board Resources Committee. She is a member of the Board of Directors of P3 – the PJM Power Providers Group, Inc. She served on the NERC Stakeholders Committee representing the Generation sector. She is currently the Chair of the Edison Electric Institute's Energy Supply Executive Advisory Committee and served for several years as the chair of the EEI Alliance Supply Policy Task Force. Gloria has served as chair of the Electric Power Supply Association (EPSA) Regulatory Affairs Committee. In PJM, Gloria coordinates the PJM Suppliers Caucus – an informal coalition of about 30 PJM companies - that collectively own more than 80% of the generating assets in PJM and serve over 80% of the PJM peak load. Gloria is very involved in her community and is on the Advisory Board of the Word of Life Christian Center in Newark Delaware. Gloria received the 2004 Award for Black Achievers in Business and Industry. She is a British Chevening Scholar and holds a Masters degree in law from the University of Leicester, United Kingdom. Gloria is a graduate of the Thunderbird Executive Finance and Accounting Program and a member of the Texas, American, and Energy Bar Associations, and the American Association of Blacks in Energy.
