James Reitzes is a Principal with The Brattle Group, who specializes in providing economic analyses and expert testimony pursuant to regulatory proceedings in the energy and transportation sectors and litigation in the areas of antitrust and competition.

Jim has provided expert analysis and testimony in energy-related matters before the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, state public utility commissions, and federal antitrust agencies. That experience includes substantial work related to wholesale energy markets, such as analyzing the competitive impact of mergers and acquisitions, assisting in the formulation of auction rules for procuring wholesale electric power supplies, analyzing portfolio-based procurement strategies for meeting standard-offer-service load obligations, evaluating existing RTO market-monitoring policies, and recommending market design changes. He also has analyzed retail electric markets extensively, including empirical examinations of customer-switching behavior and the design of transitional strategies in markets undergoing retail restructuring.

Jim has written numerous articles on optimal firm strategies with respect to prices, output, R&D investment, and quality choice, published in leading economic and legal journals. He received his Ph.D. in Economics from the University of Wisconsin, and a B.A. in Economics and History from Stanford University.
