- The nominee's state or provincial practice reflects enhanced professional competence of the practice of energy law;
- The nominee has made substantial contributions to the advancement of energy law in the state(s) or province(s) in which the nominee practices. These contributions could be through the nominees work in private practice; government service (including ALJs and public service commission staff); academia; legislative activities; or any combination of the foregoing.
- The nominee must be a member of the EBA, or must have been, a member of the EBA, for 3 or more
 years. EBA membership cannot be obtained for the sole and limited purpose of receiving the award.
